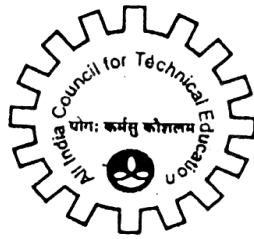

13. Strengths & Weaknesses of the institution in terms of Teaching Methodology/Transaction of Syllabus / Innovations / best practices (if any) / industrial project / Industrial consultancy / research taken up for industry and amount granted thereby:

(i) Strengths

- **We adopt learner centered teaching methods. As per Anna University norms we have faculty advisor for a small group of students. Their problems and difficulties are identified and solutions are offered in a most effective manner. Wherever possible liberal use of teaching aids like models, charts and computer simulation and animations etc., is encouraged. We have adequate number of LCD's and OHPs for use in class rooms. Number of CDS containing straining CBT (Computer based tutorials) are available in library. Lecture programmes from ' Ekalavya ' are down loaded and stored in CDs. Which are issued to students.**
- **We have dedicated team of teachers who spare no efforts in enhancing the total integrated personality of students. In spite of the poor quality of intake of students, the final results in examinations and placement are good only because of the hard work put in by the faculty.**
- **The management take special interest in career development of staff. They are being liberally sponsored for higher studies, refresher courses, seminars and conferences to update their knowledge and skills.**

(ii) Weaknesses

- **The main weakness of our college is given below:
Our college is situated in rural area and we have to admit students passing out of rural schools and they are mostly from economically and socially weaker sections of the society. Consequently they face problems related to medium of instruction and there is a wide gap between their knowledge potential and Anna University requirements. All our teachers are trying their level best to bridge this gap.**
- **As our college is situated in rural area, we are not able to attract Doctorate degree holders for faculty positions.**
